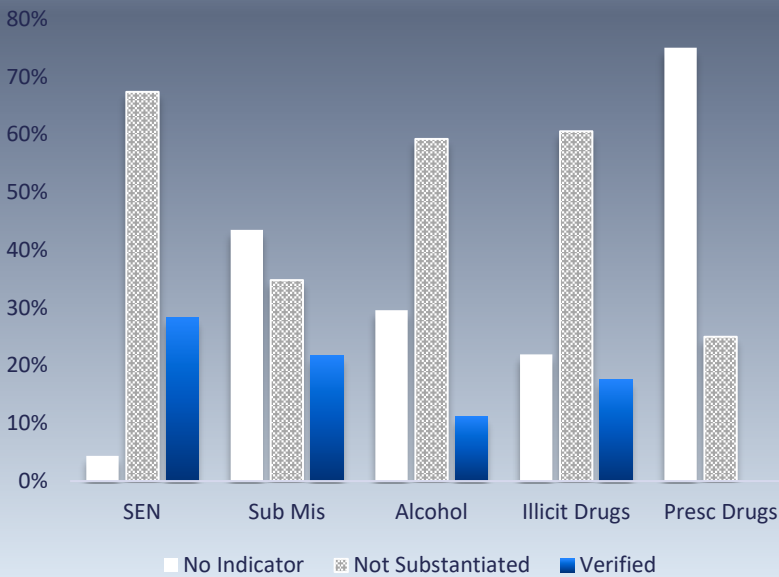


# C17 CWBH Q3 FY 20-21

## Substance Misuse Rate of Findings



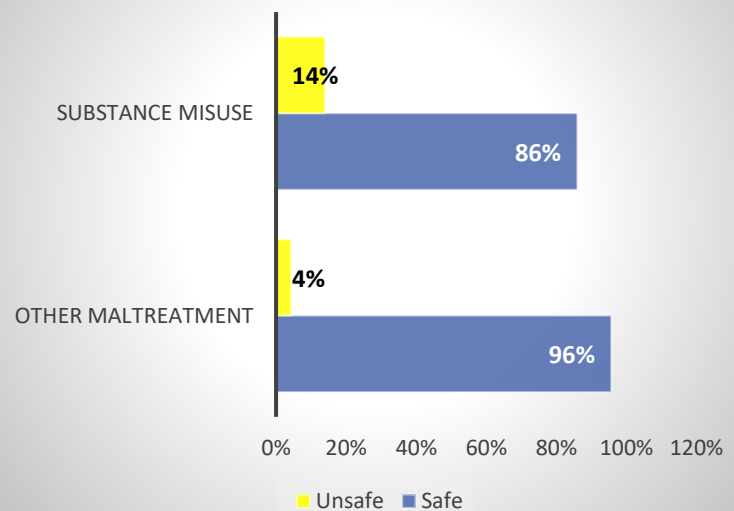
- Of the substance misuse maltreatments received during Q3 FY 20-21: 25% closed with No Indicators, 58% closed with Not Substantiated, and 16% closed with Verified findings. The highest rate of verified findings for a substance misuse maltreatment is Substance Exposed Newborn at 28%.
- In Q3 FY 20-21 the maltreatment of substance misuse contributed to a higher rate of an unsafe determination at investigative closure by 10%.

## Safety Determination by Maltreatment Type



-68% of the investigations with a substance misuse maltreatment involved a victim 5 years old or younger.  
-68 investigations closed during Q3 with a substance misuse maltreatment had a prior report within a year, 32 of the priors had a substance misuse maltreatment.



-46% of the investigations with a substance misuse maltreatment were referred to FEP. During Q3 there was a total of 273 referrals.



-641 submissions of the progress exchange form by providers for treatment were entered in FY20-21 Q3.  
- 33% received treatment for primary substance use disorder, 4% received co-occurring treatment, and 63% for polysubstance use

BHC

There were 113 BHC consultations during Q3 FY 20-21

MAT

There were 54 investigations closed during Q3 FY 20-21 that had a MAT staffing completed. There were a total of 63 MAT Staffing's completed FY 20-21 Q3

There were 69 investigations that resulted in OOHC. 49.27% of the investigations resulting on OOHC FY 20-21 Q3 had an identified substance misuse maltreatment.

76% of investigations with a substance misuse maltreatment and a BHC consultation did NOT result in children being placed into OOHC.

83.33% of investigations with a substance misuse maltreatment and a MAT Staffing did NOT result in children being placed into OOHC.
